Obert works hard to realise his dreams of being a doctor and is only happy with straight A's. Grace and Michelle are having individual and group counseling where they have made friends with teenage girls who have experienced similar traumatic experiences and are working as best they can to heal the past and do well in school.

All the children, teachers, parents and communities who have benefited from our education project have amazed us with their efforts and commitment to developing their school and becoming self sufficient. We have included a letter written by a young boy called Obert who is an orphan and lives with extended family. Young Obert started school again this year through our newest Project Batsirai in Hatfield township where we hope to expand the number of children we get back into school – with your help!
